

D-day beaches and Normandy discovery **- Walk, explore, discover the best of Normandy.**

Itinerary in full:

Day 1: Arrival day

Rouen and its magnificent medieval cathedral. Welcome dinner and evening of sightseeing in city-centre.

Day 2: Guided visit of **Rouen**, its Cathedral, market, and lunch in the city-centre. Visit the very spot where Saint Joan of Arc was burned at the stake. An afternoon warm-up hike has been planned in the forest above the city. 3-4 hours of easy walking. Dinner and night in Rouen.

Day 3: Short vehicle transfer to Fecamp via **Caen** where we will visit the peace museum and then hike to **Etretat** and its seaside resort and narrow streets. Lunch on the way. Moderate walking along chalk cliffs. 5-6 hours. Dinner and night in Etretat.

Day 4: Day hike around Etretat where **Impressionist painters** used the cliffs as a backdrop to their paintings. 5-6 hours. Picnic lunch or restaurant. Dinner and night in Etretat.

Day 5: Morning departure for **Honfleur**. Walk to harbor of this active fishing village and lunch along the picturesque quais. Afternoon guided visit of the city. Dinner and night in Honfleur.

Day 6: Transfer to **Arromanches** and begin D-Day beach tour with tour guide 4-5 hours walking on sandy beaches and on trails. Walk along **Omaha, Sword and Juno beaches**. Lunch in restaurant. Dinner and night in Arromanches.

Day 7: Saint-Mer L'Eglise,

D-Day museum and cemetery and short hike. 3-4 hours walking. Dinner and night in Arromanches.

Day 8: Transfer to **Mont Saint Michel** and its incredible fortifications. Depending on tides we will be able to hike below the massive walls of the city. Guided visit. 4-5 hours of hiking. Dinner and night at Mont Saint Michel.

Day 9: Day hike around **Mont Saint Michel**. 6-7 hours. Picnic lunch. Dinner and night Mont Saint Michel.

Day 10: Departure Day

Transfer to Paris. **Free day in Paris**. Farewell dinner.
